Fees and Charges - 2017/18

Tuition fees

Tuition fee	£4,134	£12,402

Fees are payable termly in advance. The school does accept payment by direct debit, either termly or monthly over 10 months. There is no additional charge for this service. The tuition fee includes tuition, text books, stationery and external exam entry charges for GCSE in Year 11, and A Level in Year 13.

A deposit of £400 is payable on admission and is refunded when a pupil leaves the school, less any unpaid fees and charges.

Catering charges

Catering is charged on a termly basis in advance based on the number of catering days in the coming term. No reduction is provided for fewer than five consecutive absences due to ill health.

All pupils in Thirds are required to participate in the lunch system and the termly catering charge will be added to the tuition fee in the first year.

Pupils in the Lower Fourth to Upper Fifth can either opt in or out of the catering system on a termly basis and these charges are paid separately from the tuition fee as part of the supplementary charges system administered by the school Finance Office through the school Gateway portal.

Residential school trips

There are two compulsory residential trips that girls attend in their first two years in the school. Prices for the 2015/16 year, as an indication of cost, are provided below.

Residential trip in October	All girls in Thirds (Year 7)	£95
Outdoor Adventure Trip in June	All girls in Lower Fourth (Year 8)	£370

As girls get older, they will be required to participate in Biology and Geography field trips if they choose these subjects for their public exams and these trips will also be compulsory.

Discounts and financial assistance

A tuition fee sibling discount of 25% is available for the third and subsequent child currently attending either this school or King Edward's School where parents are paying full fees for three or more siblings from the same immediate family. The school awards means-tested Assisted Places at the point of entry at 11+ and 16+ which remain with the pupil throughout their career. The school also awards scholarships for academic merit and musical ability. For details on these awards, please contact the Admissions Registrar.

West Midlands Travel provides a special service to school from both Walsall and Solihull which is shared with King Edward's School. The school is also well placed to take advantage of public transport links to University station and buses serving the Bristol Road. There is no parking available on site for pupils.
