OCR A Level Content

Language

The girls will continue their study of the Latin language, consolidating and building on the knowledge they gained at GCSE, translating increasingly complex passages with fluency. We support the girls to expand their knowledge of vocabulary by further reading and providing vocabulary lists. They will study texts written by a range of prose authors including Livy and the verse unseen author, Ovid, to develop their linguistic competence. Girls will sit two language examinations: Unseen translation (1 hour 45 minutes); Prose Composition or Comprehension (1 hour 15 minutes).

Literature

Girls will study parts of two prose and two verse set texts from a selection comprising:

- Cicero *Pro Cluentio*
- Tacitus *Annals IV*
- Livy Book 1
- Virgil *Aeneid XII*
- Catullus Poems
- Ovid *Heroides*

They will write extended answers demonstrating a personal response to the texts and evaluating literary techniques used. They will also study additional literature in translation in order to understand the context from which the set texts have been taken. There are two literature examinations: Prose Literature (2 hours); Verse Literature (2 hours).

GCSE Entry Requirements

We would like students to have achieved grade 7 – 9 in GCSE Latin to continue to A Level.
